March 13, 1934 - April 29, 2024

On a hot sunny afternoon, Melvina went to be with her creator. She departed this life on April 29, 2024 at Johns Hopkins Hospital after a brief illness.

Melvina made her entrance into the world on March 13, 1934 at 4:11 a.m. to the late Mildred Jackson and Wilbur Forrester, she was their only child, they never married.

As a Baltimore native, Melvina was raised in Turner Station by her maternal aunts; Hilda, Mary and Isabell before moving to the Catonsville area. She completed her education at Dunbar High School and took vocational training for nursing assistance. She worked in many different fields. For the better part of the 1960's she worked as a candy stripe and nursing assistant at Kernan Hospital. She then transitioned into teaching and was a teacher's aide for Baltimore City Public Schools from the 1970's through the 1990's. Then she worked at the Social Security Administration until she retired in 1997.

Melvina was spiritually enlightened from a very young age and later in life joined Self Realization Fellowship. Her dedication to daily prayer and meditation led by the teachings of Christ and Paramahansa Yogananda have aided her in her wisdom and longevity.

Though Mel has departed, her memory lives on through the family she leaves

behind.

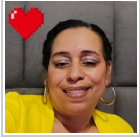
