



## Meredith Ball

November 4, 1940 - August 9, 2016

Meredith Ball was born in Richmond County, VA on November 4, 1940 to the late Wayland Edward Ball and Clara Lane Sorrell Ball. Meredith received his education in the Richmond County Public School System. He also attended Richmond County High School, located in Warsaw, VA. He was baptized early in life at his family church Mt. Zion Baptist in Downings, VA. Meredith was very social and had many friends that he remembered into his adulthood; he would often share his memories of them. As a teen, Meredith was known for his moves on the dance floor, and his love for music which continued until his passing, as he could often be found singing along to the oldies.

During his later teenage years he moved to Baltimore, MD, where he met and married his first wife Ms. Joan Ball. He worked at the old Provident Hospital on Division St. where he worked as a cook for many years. Later in his life he met and married the late Mrs. Frances "Esther" Ball and was employed at Kernan Hospital until his retirement in 1992.

"Mr. Ball", which he preferred to be called, had a great sense of humor and had a quick wit and tongue that could certainly make you laugh out loud. Meredith absolutely loved the Baltimore Orioles and could often be found watching the game on TV or listening to their games on his radio. Meredith valued family and cared deeply for his loved ones. He was a committed father and grandfather and was protective of his girls. Meredith never missed birthdays and always celebrated with his children

and grandchildren- attending all their special occasions. He also had strong bonds with his siblings- particularly his youngest brother, Frank. Meredith sincerely loved his wife, Esther Ball, whom recently preceded him in death. He passed away on what would have been their 41st anniversary.

Meredith leaves to cherish his memory: sons, daughters, stepchildren, grandchildren; one sister, Ms. Ethelene Dumas; one brother, Mr. Franklin Ball; one son-in-law and four sisters-in-law; and a host of nieces, nephews, and cousins.
