



## Miles Houston Elvoid

December 19, 1910 - May 12, 2004

Miles H. Elvoid, son of the late William E. Elvoid and Mary Burris, was born December 19, 1910 in Pevely, Missouri. He was the youngest son within a family of 13 children. The family moved to St. Louis, Missouri in 1918 where Miles completed his education in the St. Louis Public School system. He married Ethel Depp in 1928, and out of that union one son was born. Miles joined the U.S. Army in 1940 and served his country during World War II. After his discharge in 1949 he returned to St. Louis working various jobs until he moved to Des Moines, Iowa to care for a sister. He worked for Yonker's Department Store and the Home of Oakridge Apartments until his retirement in 1991. His health forced him to move to Baltimore, Maryland to live with his grandson, Houston. There he became known as "Granddad" to everyone he met. Granddad's friendly manner and sharp wit will be missed by all that have come in contact with him. His memory and knowledge of a wide range of topics could engage you in conversation for hours. He especially loved baseball, and that created a lively discussion. He leaves to cherish his memory: one son, William D. Elvoid; five grandchildren, Houston D. Elvoid, William L. Elvoid, Darlene Miller, Khadeja Abdur-Raqib, and Judy Temple; fourteen great-grandchildren; eleven great great-grandchildren, and a host of nieces, nephews and other relatives.
