July 12, 1942 - October 28, 2015

MIREN RUSSELL MCCOY, son of and the late Winfield Scott McCoy, was born on July 12, 1942 in Baltimore, Maryland. He was called home to God's Kingdom on Wednesday, October 28, 2015, after a lengthy illness.

Miren received his education in the Baltimore City Public School system. He met "The Lord" in his early years while attending Saint Matthews Methodist Church and Saint Paul Baptist Church. He was raised in a loving family environment, having twelve siblings: Lillian, Doretha, Elaine, Barbara, Jeanette, Marlene, Gilbert, Angela, Lynell, Marty (deceased), Geraldine (deceased), and Leslie (deceased).

Miren worked at Fort Bragg in North Carolina as a civilian for many years. He later returned to Baltimore where he acquired several contractual jobs at Memorial Stadium, Morgan State University and various apartment complexes around Baltimore.

Miren was blessed to have four children, Joanie, JoAnne, Miren, Jr. and Byren. Miren also had a godson, Derrick O'Neal; four grandchildren, Miren III, Laniara and Devin McCoy, Morgan Smith; one god grandson, Tyler O'Neal and four great-grandchildren, Taniya, Kiren, Aniya, and Liam.

Miren was a proud member of the Freeloaders Social Club. He met new

friends and considered “Ike” an adopted brother.

In February 2015, Miren became ill and later to Future Care for Rehabilitation. The staff shared comments that “Miren was the nicest patient but demanding, very outspoken and funny, and could take matters into his own hands.

Miren leaves to cherish his memory: his wife Ruth McCoy; two daughters, two sons, one daughter-in-law, one godson, four grandchildren, a god grandchild, four great-grandchildren, nine surviving siblings, and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and other relatives, and longtime friends.
