Mirricco Williams "Pee Wee" was born, May 8, 1958, in Baltimore, Maryland to the late Robert and Essie Williams. Mirricco was fondly known as "Pee Wee" by those who knew and loved him. He transitioned from this life back to God on Friday, September 23, 2022, after a lengthy illness.

Mirricco attended Baltimore City Public Schools. He worked at the Maryland School for the Blind for 35 years. He worked with children that were disabled and visually impaired. While there he was loved by many of the staff. He always made you laugh by the things he would say. He always said emphatically that he believed the people at MSB really did love him and he saw them as family. He also worked at the Children's home for several years. He continued pouring into children who were discarded and forgotten by families. He mentored a couple of the children and stayed in contact with them even into their adulthood.

Mirricco was baptized in the name of Jesus Christ in May of 1987 and later was filled with the Holy Ghost under the late Pastor Lucille Calloway of Faith Tabernacle Apostolic Church in Baltimore, Maryland. This experience with God did change a lot of things with him.

Mirricco Williams married in October of 1987 and out of that union two children were born: Brandon and Justin Williams. The marriage ended but the friendship remained.

Mirricco loved cooking and he was noted for his fried Twinkies. The children and adults loved them and it made him so proud to cook them. He also made an awesome spaghetti that is still in use today. Not only was cooking a skill; he also had a unique talent for arts and crafts. he would design beautiful, framed 3D pictures from his own creation using scraps of items that would be discarded. He will be remembered for his laugh and love of a good time.

Mirricco was preceded in death by his parents; two brothers, Maurice and Travis Williams.

Mirricco leaves to cherish his memory; his beloved sons, Brandon Williams of Baltimore, Maryland and Justin Williams of Los Angeles, California, his two sisters; Maxine Williams of Greenville, North Carolina, and Diane Williams of Baltimore, Maryland, three nieces; Machon and Ebony both of Greenville, North Carolina, and Ashley of Madison, WI, one nephew; Robert from Greenville, North Carolina, Five great nieces, three great nephews, one great niece and a host of other relatives and friends.
