Monica Pinkett was born April 18, 1970 to Beverly A. Pinkett of Baltimore, MD and the late Forest Crockett of Blacksburg, Sc. Monica was the youngest of eight siblings. She was preceded in death by her father, Forest Crockett, Sr. She was a very positive, inspirational, beautiful, and loving person.

Monica was a dual graduate of Frederick Douglass High School Class of 1988 and Westside Skill Center from which she obtained her cosmetology license. She made and maintained lasting friendships with many of her classmates from elementary through high school. She took great pride in organizing and spear heading numerous class reunion events throughout the years; so much so that she became the face of the FDHS Class of 1988.

As a young adult, Monica professed her faith in Jesus Christ. She was a committed member of Shiloh Christian Community Church where she served faithfully on the Holy Host "Greeter's" Ministry.
