Monica loved her family very much, and was always welcoming when we would stop by. Her door was always open, all were greeted with a warm smile and outstretched arms. She loved to laugh, and loved when family members and friends would tell her jokes and funny stories. She was also a wonderful cook and would never let you leave her home without a full stomach.
