Although Moni had a love for fashion she also enjoyed music and reading. Mo really took pride in being a loving mother and wife.

Monique was a hard worker and maintained several positions in the workforce. Due to her illness she retired from Carroll County Dept. of Social

Service as a Family Support Worker April 2016.

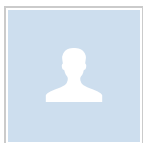

Monique was an amazing mother, friend, co-worker and social worker. She was one of those people you dream of having in your life and never want to let go. Every time I saw her, even on her roughest days and through physical and emotional pain she always remained positive and put others first.

Finding someone who is as strong, positive, passionate, loving, beautiful, caring and selfless is an opportunity that not everyone gets. I found all those things in Mo and consider myself blessed to have had her in my life. On top of all of these traits, she also had an amazing sense of humor!

We really bonded during my pregnancy with my 2nd child, at which point she was pregnant with Elias. We were due only a few months apart compared baby bumps during our frequent pregnancy-induced potty breaks. A few months after my son was born my autoimmune disease, which went into remission during my pregnancy, came back full force. This brought with it a number of complications including not being able to keep up with the breastmilk my son needed. Mo stepped right up and donated milk to my son. Having friends willing to share that kind of love with your child is more amazing than be described in words.

The light of this world grew a bit dimmer in the early morning of 8/7/16. Monique was a blessing to everyone who knew her. I am grateful to know she is at peace but I mourn for myself, Jamal, Elias, Mimi, Jackie and all that have been left with a Mo shaped void in their hearts.
