Montel was born on December 30, 1965, in Richmond, Virginia, to Christine and the late Linwood Davenport, Sr. He was preceded in death by his brother, Linwood Davenport, Jr.

Montel completed his K–12 education and earned his high school diploma. A pivotal moment in his life came in March of 2018, at the age of 52, when he accepted Christ as his Savior and united with Speaking Spirit Ministries under the leadership of Apostle Fred Wyatt.
