Sisters and Brothers-Morris was reared with six other children-Constance, Bernice, Robert, Roberta, Bernard, Hilda-all of whom preceded him in death. They grew up in Church Hill at 610 N. 27th Street.

Religious Education- Morris was a life long member of First African Baptist Church.

Academic Education- Morris attended Buchanan Elementary and Armstrong High School.

Military Duty/Employment-Morris served his country during World War II and later worked for the Federal Government as a letter carrier in Richmond and Washington D.C. for over 30 years.

Marriage/Friendships-He was married to the late Mary Elizabeth Jones. He had two special friends, Gladys Benjamin and Louise Perkins Ashton, who

preceded him in death.

Father/Grandfather/Father-in-law/Uncle- He was “Dad, Daddy, Granddaddy” to five children, six grandchildren, two great grandchildren, and two daughters-in-law. He was the “favorite” uncle to his “favorite” nieces and nephews and great nieces and nephews.

Retirement- During his retirement, he worked part-time as a taxi driver in Washington, D.C. He eventually returned to Richmond and spent his final years at Imperial Plaza and Lucy Corr Village.

Departure- On January 5, 2016, Morris’s story ended. He took the flight like “mighty eagle” and flew home to his eternal rest. He will be missed, but his sense of humor and his loving spirit are etched in our minds and hearts.
