Mozelle Hicks Burt was born in Richmond, Virginia on July 10, 1939 to the late Leslie Hicks Sr. and Irene Hicks. She was preceded in death by her three brothers, George, Leslie Jr. and William Hicks. She entered into eternal rest at her home in Varina on August 1, 2017 after a courageous and heroic battle with cancer.

Mozelle graduated from Maggie L Walker High School in 1958. She accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior at an early age and attended Moore Street Baptist Church. She later continued her spiritual journey and joined Resurrection Lutheran Church where she served the Lord for many years.

On February 17, 1962, she was joined in holy matrimony to Edward Burt, Sr. To this union five children were born. After raising her family, she returned to the workforce in 1995 where she was a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) at Madison House Assisted Living facility. She retired in September 2014 due to her health. Mozelle affectionately known as "Ms. Moe", was given the gift as a caregiver. She was a private duty caregiver for many years caring for the elderly. Her selfless spirit and love for family and friends was displayed throughout the community by her willingness to help those in need.
