FREEDIE MUTWALE MANGI was born on March 17, 1977 in Kolwezi (Katanga) in the Democratic Republic of Congo. He was the beloved son of the late Honorable Albert Muyange Mangi and Christiane Kinyata Mwape. He unexpectedly and mysteriously departed this life on Thursday, August 13, 2015 at the tender age of 37, when his body was found in the waters of the Baltimore Inner Harbor.

Freddie received his early education in the primary and secondary school system of Kolwezi. In his high school years, he attended the prestigious Technical Institute of Mutoshi. He was a brilliant student and he received many honors in the country's state exam.
