Minister Myron Nahaniel Davis, born August 28, 1972 in Allendale, South Carolina, to Pearlie and Bruce Davis. Min. Davis was called from labor to reward on June 19, 2018.

Myron was raised in a Christian household, and at an early age he joined St. Luke Baptist Church in Fairfax, South Carolina. He continued his Christian walk, and in September of 2006, He would preach his initial sermon at Elkridge Baptist Church in Elkridge, Maryland.

Bubba, as he was affectionately called, also knew at an extremely early age that he would be an Undertaker. He would tell stories of how he used a wagon as his hearse, and would bury GI Joes, toy soldiers and other toys in the yard. It was especially great for him if someone actually experienced the death of a pet! The little undertaker would have a service with "real life" mourners! He

spent much of his time at Garvin and Garvin Funeral Home, watching and imitating his grandfather.

After graduating from Estill High School in 1990, Bubba would begin his childhood dream of becoming an undertaker. He would attend Gupton Jones College of Funeral Services in Atlanta, Georgia. Anxious to begin his career, he would leave school after obtaining a Certificate in Funeral Service, but returned in 2010 to get an Associate of Applied Science Degree.

Beginning his career in Georgia, with Donald Trimble Mortuary, he worked tirelessly to perfect his skills. Myron quickly became known as "the Funeral Director's Funeral Director". He would marry in 1998, and the joy of his life, Darius Nathaniel Davis, would be born in November of that year. Myron would move to Baltimore with his family, in hope of better opportunities. Myron's hours would prove to be too much for his family and his first marriage would end.

Once in Baltimore, Myron would continue to develop his skills even more. Working for William C. Brown Community Funeral Home, and then Vaughn C. Greene Funeral Services on a full-time basis, before beginning his trade embalming career. Funeral Directors from all over the country would call for his input or directions with difficult cases. Everything that he would learn, he wanted to share, and he would not waste time with people that he thought "were not serious about this business".

During a cemetery committal service in December of 2001, he would lock eyes with the councilor, Debra Green, who was working with a family. Over the next few months, they went out of their way to run into each other, and by April of 2002 the two were great friends. Before long they were inseparable. They married August 18, 2007. He convinced Debra to attend Mortuary school and she would graduate and get her Mortician's license in 2008. He poured all

that he could into his wife and said frequently that he did not want people to "pee down her back and tell her it was raining." He'd hoped to someday open a family funeral home, but it was not to be.

Myron leaves to celebrate his life and share precious memories; devoted wife, Debra Green-Davis; his reason for wanting to leave a legacy, Darius Nathaniel Davis; bonus-son, Kevin P. Rucker II; loving parents, Pearlie and Bruce Davis; mother-in-law, Helen J.
