Myrtle Pauline Brooks was born in Fayetteville, North Carolina on April 28, 1916. She was the youngest of three daughters born to the late George N. Thigpen and the late Nellie Bryant Thigpen. She departed this life suddenly on April 23, 2002 at Hammonds Lane Center Nursing Home. She was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System. She met and married Herman R. Brooks on November 15, 1931 in Baltimore, Md., and from that union came six sons; Herman, Carl, Kenneth, John, Wayne and Craig. Herman and Myrtle were married 62 loving years. Myrtle worked hard all of her life in the clothing industry to provide a good work ethic and support for her family until she retired. She was a member of Mt.
