Nancy Sue Bunche was born August 5, 1948 to Doris Hedgebeth Moore and the late Wiley Moore, Sr. and Doris Hedgebeth Moore in Plymouth, North Carolina. She is preceded in death by her husband, Sherman Bunche, Jr. At an early age, Nancy was baptized at New Chapel Missionary Baptist Church in Plymouth, North Carolina. Nancy was educated in the Washington County School system and graduated from Plymouth High School in 1966. She was the first family member to graduate from an integrated high school. Upon completion of high school, Nancy migrated to New York where she met her future husband, Sherman Bunche, Jr. They were married on August 3, 1983. Nancy was employed by The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey as a Records Management Clerk and a Toll Collector, respectively. Due to a serious vehicle accident, Nancy was medically retired in 1991. While retired, Nancy decided to further her education and attended Bronx Community College.
