June 26, 1917 - April 21, 2009

On Tuesday April 21, 2009 at 4:45 a.m., life's voyage came to an end for NANCY CORNELIA SNOWDEN. Born in Halifax County, Virginia on June 26, 1917, she was the daughter of the late Edward Lee Hubbard and Mary Ellen Price Hubbard. She received her education in the Shiloh public school system. Nancy moved to Baltimore, Maryland in 1940. She was united in marriage to the late James Henry Snowden in 1942. Nancy began her faith journey in Halifax, VA and came into full bloom at The Christian Community Church of God, under the late Elder Conway Green. She remained active, strong in mind, will and faith until the time of her passing. She was extremely proud of her family, generations of which have been motivated and directed by the values she imparted to them. She was a loving and devoted matriarch of her family and loving and loyal friend. She especially enjoyed her times with Mr. Allen Thomas, who was one of her neighbors.
