Naomi Mary Ford, daughter of the late Grover Cleveland and Helen Martin was born in Winston Salem, North Carolina on October 10, 1914. She departed this life on Saturday, November 9, 2002 at Union Memorial Hospital. After the death of her father, Naomi moved with her mother to Virginia, then to Baltimore where her mother married Byrd Owens. They raised Naomi with their seven other children. Naomi attended public schools in North Carolina, Virginia and Maryland. She later met Weldon Ford and was married on January 23, 1935 in Suffolk, Virginia. Jack and Mary as they were called, were married for almost fifty years when he passed in 1986. Mary held many jobs throughout her lifetime. She trained as a home care worker that enabled her to nurse her husband during his long illness. She was also employed at the University of Maryland Dental School for several years. Mary attended the Shiloh Christian Community Church for many years under the leadership of Rev. George Baynard, however in recent years she enjoyed visiting smaller area churches. When she was unable to attend regular services she enjoyed listening to religious services by radio, while reading and studying the bible.
