Nathan Cornelius White, Sr. was born on September 24, 1944, in New York City to the late William and Georgia White. He entered eternal rest on April 10, 2018, at his home in Sandston, Virginia. Nathan briefly grew up in the Bronx and in his late teenage years he relocated to King George, Virginia. He attended Ralph Bunche High School but later graduated from AT Johnson High School. After graduating, he enlisted into the United States Air Force in June of 1964 and was honorably discharged with the rank of Staff Sargent. He was married in 1966, in which four children were born as a result of this union – Denise, Nathan Jr., Sandra, and Pamela.

He worked for District of Columbia Department of Corrections retiring after 25 years of dedicated service. He continued to work after retirement because of his love of helping others. He was an active and proud member and brother of the Lord Hannibal Masonic Lodge 327 pha, where as he rose to the 33rd degree of Masonry.

In August 1997, he remarried Brenda Green in Richmond, VA and welcoming

her child as his own, Tory Green.
