Ned Thomas Drumgoole Sr., son of the late Vannie and Jennie Drumgoole, was born July 12, 1921 in Dinwiddie County, Virginia. He departed this life on December 12, 2003. 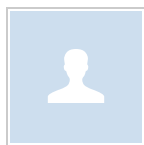

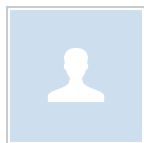

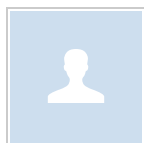
