Mrs. Nellie Margaret McCoy was born July 9, 1909 to the late James A. and Eliza Butler Goldring, in Bryantown, Charles County, Maryland. "Nellie" as she was affectionately known by her family and friends moved to Baltimore at a very young age after completing her former education at St. Mary's Catholic School in Charles County, Maryland. She remained a faithful member in Catholicism for many years. As a young woman, during the war years, she was first employed at Edgewood Arsenal and later employed by Continental Tin Decorators, retiring with twenty-five years of service. When Nellie met "Willie" she found a "soul mate," they shared a long friendship and were married in New Shiloh Baptist Church on, January 29, 1949, by the late Reverend Timothy Boodie. She wanted us to know they shared a very long happy life together, and that God has blessed them "exceeding, abundantly above all that they could ask or think." A short period, after the wedding, her husband became a member of New Shiloh, while later, under the spiritual leadership of Reverend Dr. Harold A. Carter. Sr., in June of 1976, she became a baptized believer joining her husband in membership at New Shiloh. Sister McCoy was a faithful member of New Shiloh Baptist Church, until illness limited her participation; serving as a member of the "Flower Circle and Senior Circle always ready to give of her time, service and resources as needed. Many will remember her kind sharing spirit and concerned for the welfare of others. Above all else, Nellie wants us to remember, it was prayer and faith in Christ that sustained her, as life made that final turn towards eternity as she often said "The Lord was the answer to everything." She leaves to cherish her memory: a devoted husband, William J. McCoy; two nieces, Gloria Johnson and Consuella M.
