NELLIE UNDERWOOD was one of nine children born to Joseph and Carrie Campbell on May 20, 1924. She received her education in the Baltimore City Public School System and worked briefly in a restaurant. After her mother's passing she helped raise her younger siblings. She married her childhood neighbor and friend William E. Underwood, Sr. on August 15, 1943 for whom she expressed a deep and sincere love and affectionately called "El." During their 70 years of marriage they shared in the birth of their 10 children: Russell, Shirley, Beatrice, William Jr., Carl, Paulette, Michael, Lorraine, Diane, and Joyce.

She was a devoted wife and mother who spent much time and effort sharing her love of Bible teachings with her family and neighbors via the public ministry since her dedication and baptism as a Jehovah's Witness in 1961.
