



## Obi O. Mangrover

October 27, 1951 - September 29, 2016

Dr Obi Okonkwo-Mangrover JD, also known as Anthony Okonkwo, a native of Umuoji, Anambra State, Nigeria, son of the Late Chief Godwin Animalu Okonkwo Mangrover (Ichie Isienyi 1 of Umuoji) and Mrs Catherine Nnonye Okonkwo (Ezenwa), was born on June 27, 1957 at Ogidi, Anambra State, Nigeria and departed this life on September 29, 2016 after a brief illness.

He received his high school education at Christ the King college (CKC), Onitsha, Nigeria and went on to Morgan State University, Baltimore, Maryland where he obtained his first degree in Political Science (1977-1981). He then proceeded to North Eastern University Law School, Boston, Massachusetts where he obtained his Doctor of Law, LL.D degree (1982 – 1986).
