OKECHUKU GUY OKEKE was born December 24, 1947 in Umunachi, Anambra State, Nigeria to the late John Ofodile and Priscilla (Ugochukwu) Okeke. His soul went to rest from this life Saturday, April 22, 2023.

Okechuku attended secondary school at St. Augustine's (C.M.S.) Grammar School Nkwerre. He went on to graduate from the New York Institute of Technology with a double major in Chemistry and Biology in 1979. He finished his formal education obtaining his medical degree from Universidad Mundial Dominicana in 1985.

On August 21, 1983, he married Florence Obiageli Madukife in Baltimore, Maryland where they have lived ever since.

Ever the athlete, he was the Games and Sports Master while working as a teacher at Igwebike Grammer School Awka shortly after graduating from secondary school. While at university, he played with the North American Soccer League side New York Cosmos and had the honor of playing with world soccer legend, Pele.

The first of his family to leave Nigeria, he was the first peg of the Okeke Onyilikolo family in the United States, where he endeavored to represent them

well and bring resources back to his home area.

He leaves to cherish his memory: his wife Florence Okeke; daughter, Nneka Okeke; son, Ndubisi Okeke; brother Nathan Okeke; sister Maggie Okeke; several nieces and nephews, and a host of other relatives and kinsmen. He will be greatly missed by his entire family.
