



## Oliver Cornelius Budd

April 2, 1932 - March 19, 2002

Oliver C. Budd Sr., son of the late Worick Newton Budd and Leanna Elizabeth Budd, was born on April 4, 1932 in Potomac, Maryland. On March 19, 2002 Budd succumbed to God's will and departed this earth at the age of sixty-nine. He received his education in the Rockville school system, after which time he entered the United States Army during the Korean Conflict, where he received the Bronze Star Medal while participating in the infamous "Pork Chop Hill Siege." He also received the United Nations Service Medal. After a distinguished army career, he returned to civilian life where he met and later married Jewel E. Walker. Out of this union four children were born, Oliver Jr., Fredrick Michael, Dwayne Anthony and Irish Maria. He also had another daughter Diane Sewell. Simply known as "Budd" or "Oliver" by those who knew him well, he worked many years with the Baltimore Lumber Company and the Horstmeier Lumber Company as a truck driver. He also did seasonal work for the Bay Island Seafood Company. Budd's work ethic was exceptional, hardly missing a day, never being late. Yet he still made time to indulge in his favorite pastime which was fishing. He also enjoyed walking around Lake Montebello each and every morning before failing health prevented him from continuing his daily regimen. Anyone, who knew Budd knew him to be a simple, uncomplicated man and faithful, dedicated husband and father. Those who walk past his house and no longer see him sitting on the porch will most assuredly know what it means to lose a neighbor from the old school who knew what the word neighbor really meant. He will be sorely

missed. He leaves to mourn: two daughters, Diane Sewell and Irish Myers; as well as two sons, Joseph Walker and Dwayne Budd; three sisters, Sadie Wagner, Ernestine Davis and Salestine Armstead; one brother-in-law, William Wagner; two sisters-in-law, Sarah Budd and Lucille Budd; eight grandchildren, two great grandchildren and a host of devoted family and friends.
