The recreation personnel, parents, and team members all commended Woody for the time he sacrificed to work with the young boy, and highly applauded him for his athletic skills as well. But, as strong as his love of basketball was, it could not compare with the love he had for his mother, children and family. He was a very family-oriented person. He had a very special and unique relationship with his mother. The two of them seemed inseparable at times. Tinkie grew up in the

home with his cousins, Ronaldo and Andrea, and they both looked up to him as their big brother. The family and anyone who knew them could see the kind of bond they possessed. Woody met the love of his life Towanda Grant (Tonya) and immediately they formed a loving and caring relationship. They were blessed to have each other and it showed in every aspect.
