Oliver Norman Moore, the son of the late David and Alethia Moore was born on May 6, 1924 in Halifax County, North Carolina. He departed this life on Tuesday, May 27, 2003 at Sinai Hospital. Oliver affectionately known as "Tab" was educated in the North Carolina school system. He served his country in the Army Air Force during World War II. 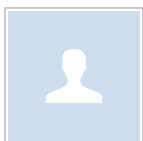
