Although he was unable to attend services regularly, he was a member of Zion Baptist Church and maintained a consistent prayer life often praying for his family, church family, and pastor.

Ollie Grissom was the second eldest of eleven siblings. He was preceded in death by brothers Otis Grissom (wife Linda); Robert Grissom (wife Della), Willie Edward Grissom (wife Philameia) and sisters Lottie Louise Powell (husband Oliver, deceased), Myrtle Davis (husband Arthur, deceased), Bettie
