Its forever burnished in my mind. I'm so sorry that I didn't take the 5 mins. You were a sweet, kind, gentle soul and a great friend. Every time I hear the word census, I forever think of you and all the fun we had jumping from computer to computer, competing against each other to see who could finish their work the fastest, and I smile. I remember the conversations about us sharing similar heart palpitations. I often think of it all and till this day, I still wonder what I was supposed to learn from it all.
