



Orlando "Roosevelt" Jones

September 24, 1931 - August 18, 2017

Orlando "Roosevelt" Jones of Cameron, North Carolina; formerly Blythville, Arkansas, and Westminster, Maryland, passed quietly and gently rest on Friday, August 18, 2017.

Roosevelt was born September 24, 1931, Easton Maryland to the late Alvin Jones and Gladys Marie Napper Jones.

Roosevelt was drafted into the United States Army and ended his military career when he retired from the United States Army Air Force on September 1, 1974. He served in the military with honor and distinction and was stationed at Greenland Germany, Italy, Saudi Arabia, Guam. He was also stationed at Westover Air Force Base in Massachusetts, Andrews Air Force Base in Maryland, and McGuire Air Force Base in New Jersey. Roosevelt also retired from the U.S. Army in 1988.

Roosevelt received his education in the Baltimore Public School System and after the military earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Computer Science from Hood College and National Lewis University.

Roosevelt was an avid reader, very knowledgeable about many subjects, interested in learning new things, and could carry on a conversation about many subjects, but his first passion was electronics.

Along with his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister Dorothy

McCutheaon; five brothers; Mitchell, Alvin, Wilbur, Donald, and Vernon.
