Paige B. Jones was born September 6, 1915, in Nassawadox, Virginia, to Walter Bailey, Sr. and Estelle Upshur Bailey. The family relocated to Baltimore Maryland where Paige received her education in the Baltimore City Public School System. Paige then went on to attend Coppin Normal Teachers College, which is now Coppin State University. For over 40 years she was a primary education teacher in the Baltimore City School Systems.

Upon being introduced to the true religion. Paige and her mother eagerly took hold and in October 1945 symbolized her dedication to Jehovah by her water baptism. Sister Jones took every opportunity to pioneer and auxiliary pioneer to help others learn about Jehovah.

She married Melvin Jones in 1953. They both loved Jehovah and enjoyed working together in the ministry until his death in 1991. However, Sister Jones continued active in the ministry right up until her death.
