The sunshine of the incomparable Pamela Beatrice Motley McMullen rose on Sunday, October 17th, 1957 and set exactly 67 years later on Sunday, October 17th, 2021. A being of light, who shone vibrantly and exuberantly on everyone she encountered, her favorite self-descriptor was "I'm special!" and by example gave everyone else around her permission to be special as well.

Affectionately known as Pam, she was born in Richmond, Virginia and spent her first decade in Henrico County, VA until the family relocated to Northside Richmond. Pam's Richmond Public Schools education culminated as a 1973 graduate of Thomas Jefferson High School where she was co-captain of the wildly popular, award-winning Mighty Vikings Cheer Squad. Her fondness for learning compelled her to perpetually continue her educational journey via VSU, VCU (BA, M.ED), JMU, Hampton U., as well as J. Sergeant Reynolds, John Tyler & Randolph-Macon Community Colleges, associates and/or certifications from each institution along the way.

Pamela's final career position as a Special Education Teacher with the Department of Juvenile Justice at Bon Air Correctional Center was one in which she cherished the positive impact she had on the youth that she instructed and the uplifting camaraderie of her co-workers. Her professional life however, spanned many careers. As a Master Seamstress, not only was she exceptionally skilled but was an entrepreneur, launching her sewing

business, The Creators, in her early 20's and operated it for over 30 years. One of her favorite and most spoken of work experience was her time at Thalhimers Department Store as a Department Leader and Personal Shopper.

Anywhere there was good eating, game playing, loud singing, tight hugging, hard laughing and bright living, Pam was in the mix. She was a lover of all people, from all of the neighborhood children and currently grown "kids" who call her Mama Pam, to her co-workers and community, she collected friends. Literally all who met her immediately loved her warm spirit and vibrant smile and she always welcomed them in her life, family heart and home. As a natural born leader and visionary her creative juices were limitless. There was always a design or solution lurking in her mind for any idea, design of concept. She generously fostered and supported the ambitions and projects of her kindness, compassion, wisdom and humor. Her permanent impact on the World around her and the people within it is deeply felt and cherished.

Pamela's transcension was preceded by her adoring parents, Joseph Motley, Sr. and Beatrice Viola Tyler Motley Cole. Left to bask in her light is her husband, Wilbur "Billy" McMullen, Sr., her four beloved children, aka her "elements": Nichole "Nickey"-water, Ayanna-earth, Wilber "Billy", Jr.-air & Jada McMullen- fire and six doting grandchildren, Micah, Joi, Jonah, Jaden, Zoe & Josiah. She also leaves eight siblings by birth, Joseph " Chucky" Motley, Sr., Michael Motley, Sr. (Billie), Deborah Boldin, Alexander Motley, Sr. (Sandra).
