Pansy Roger Wimbush was born on February 2, 1938 to the late Gracie Jones and Aben Wimbush in Danville, Virginia. Pansy attended elementary school in Danville and completed her studies by earning her GED in 1968. In 1944, Pansy married King Solomon Plunkett in Pittsylvania, Virginia. In 1961, she moved to Baltimore where she raised her four children. She fostered over 47 children, two of whom she adopted. She became a member of New Saint Mark Baptist Church in 1971 and a watch member of the Tree of Life Bible Church in 1989. Pansy served as president of New Saint Mark's usher board and the president of The Tree of Life Bible Church's junior usher board.

Pansy, "Momma and Nanna" as she was affectionately called, will be remembered for her heart to serve and her love for children. She spearheaded fundraisers for the church, organized annual church shopping trips to Englishtown (Momma never had more than \$2.00), summer trips for the neighborhood children, weekly bus trips for the senior community and most importantly, she provided a home for anyone in need. Pansy had never met a stranger. If you knew her, you were a dear friend or one of her children.

Pansy leaves to mourn four children; Alice "Loretta", Manual "Ray", Rodney Leonard, George Lamar, Raymond Darnell Sr. and Jesse Clyde, whom proceeded her in death. She leaves 10 grandchildren; Marcia, Shannon Sr., Tavon, Nataska "Nita", Maurice, Chennelle, Parrish, London and Raymond Jr.
