Pard Lee Bellinger, lovingly known as “Rocky,” was born on February 10, 1949 in Chester, Pennsylvania to Mrs. Erma Dean and the late Eugene Bellinger. On Tuesday, April 1, 2003, he quietly passed into the peaceful arms of God after a lengthy illness. He received his education in the Savannah, Georgia School system. Pard started to work at an early age. Pard was a barber at age sixteen, before joining Job Corps. He was also employed at the Albany Medical Center in New York.
