Whenever you would see Superintendent, you saw Mother. She loved her children and grandchildren and taught them the power of prayer and faith. Along with her husband Superintendent Weatherspoon, they founded the Redeem Church of God In Christ where she served as First Lady for over 36 years. Mother Weatherspoon served in many capacities in the church, Sunday School Superintendent, Adult Choir, Missionary Board, Prayer Warrior, Church Administrator. Mother Weatherspoon worked diligently and untiringly in the Missions Department, raising funds, clothing, medical supplies and toiletries for the orphanages she visited yearly in Haiti. During Superintendent's illness and passing, Mother lovingly cared for him and remained a 'tower of strength' for her family, church and friends. After much prayer and fasting by Mother, God greatly proved himself to her as she re-established the Temple of Hope Ministry. Mother weathered the storms. She experienced many hurts, disappointments and pain but through it all she remained faithful to her God. Through her ministry at the Temple of Hope,
