



## Patricia Ann Woods-Hamilton

February 10, 1934 - July 24, 2005

Patricia Ann Woods-Hamilton, a native Baltimorean, was a force to be reckoned with. She was the eldest daughter of the late Leo Chancely and Geneva Rainey Woods both of Baltimore. She completed her early education in Baltimore City schools, graduating from Dunbar High School. In her brilliance, she entered Morgan College, now Morgan University, at age 16. After receiving her undergraduate degree, she began her teaching career in Leonardtown, Maryland. She combined her love of teaching with her love of reading and books, and went on to complete a Library Science degree at the University of Southern California, Los Angeles. She started work as a librarian in the Los Angeles Public Library System. In 1960, she was chosen to be a Golden Girl hostess (Kennedy Girl) for the upcoming Democratic National Convention and eventually became an active member of the Los Angeles Young Democrats. She eventually began work for the Los Angeles Unified School District as a teacher-librarian at the Ralph Bunche Junior High School in Compton. Here, she was respected as a fearless woman with many students looking up to her in this gang infested school in South Central Los Angeles. While in Los Angeles she met and married Simon Hamilton in 1961. Resulting from that union were her two children, Douglas and Patrice. With threats of cutbacks, she applied for a job with Department of Defense Dependent Schools (DODDS), was offered and accepted a position in Germany. For the next ten years she served as the librarian at the Nuremberg American High School, Nuremberg Germany. With summers off, and spurred

by her adventurous nature, she and her family spent those summers driving through and visiting most of the countries in Western Europe. Patricia returned to the States to work in the Baltimore City School System as a librarian until her retirement in 2000. She is survived by her children, Douglas Chancely and Patrice Simone; her sister, Leonore Jocelyn Burts; her aunt, Mary Tates; her nieces, Michelle Feist, and LisetteAbdiruhman; her grand nieces and nephews, numerous cousins and friends.
