Patricia Ann McCoy, affectionately known as "Pat-Pat" was born June 22, 1941, in Mount Claire, New Jersey to the union of James and Annie Puryear. As a child, Pat was lovingly raised by her grandparents Samuel and Ida B. Taylor in Cumberland, Virginia. She was the eldest of six siblings: James, Ida, Richard, Herman, and Linda.

Patricia was charismatic, opinionated and strong-willed. Earlier in life Pat attended Turkey Cock Elementary and Luther P. Jackson High School. At the age of 18, she moved to Chicago, Illinois, where she attended Marion College of Commerce.

On March 5, 1962, Patricia was joined in marriage to James Lee McCoy. From this union they produced five children: Mark, Nanci, Cornell (Kevin), Parnell (Keith), and Jacinda. After attending college, Pat became an insurance adjuster for Ben Franklin Inc. However, her career path lead her to become a book bindery supervisor at Frank's Bindery for fifteen years.

In 1983, a decision was made to relocate to Virginia to help her mother "Missy" and her Grandmother Ida. Self-employment allowed more time with family and friends. Her favorite pastimes included cooking, entertaining, gardening, reading, and shopping.

Family and friends often described Pat as a caring, giving, and loving individual. Children and grandchildren loved to spend time with her during the holidays. Pat was an amazing mother and grandmother.

Left to cherish her memories are her five children: Mark (Donita), Nanci (Rodney), Cornell, Parnell (Teresa), and Jacinda (Shannon Sr.).
