Pat received his education in the Baltimore City Public School System, graduating from Northwestern Senior High School. He received Christ at Sweet Hope Freewill Baptist Church under the late John T. Crummedy where he served on the Usher Board. He later joined Mt. Sinai Baptist Church in 2011 under Pastor Ray A. Cotton Sr.

During his high school journey he began working at Montgomery Ward, where he worked until the company closed down. After that time he worked at numerous jobs until he joined Form Service, Inc., in May of 1988, where he remained until his death.

On August 10, 1974 he married the late Sherry P. Boykin. During this time there were four children, Kevin(Kyndra)Dunn, Patrese, Patricia, and Janelle Boykin; grandchildren Kiara(JaQuan), LaQuanna Davon), Darius, and Tyrek; great-great-grandson, Bryce King Smith.

On October 15, 2010, Pat married Francine Brown and with this marriage joined Antoinette Best and Bernadette Joyce; six grandchildren, and eight great-grandchildren.
