Paul D. Jacobs, son of the late Lester Jacobs and Pearl Jacobs, was born on December 1, 1925 in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. He departed this life on December 7, 2001 after a brief illness at the Joseph Richey Hospice in Baltimore City. He moved to North Carolina then later came to Baltimore in 1930, and was raised by and aunt, the late Sarah Jackson. He attended Baltimore City public schools. He was known by many of his friends as “Mr. Paul”. He served in the United States Marine Corps from 1952 to 1954. He later married the late Anna Jacobs who preceded him in death in 1981.
