Paul F. Carter III was born in Baltimore, Maryland on October 25, 1960. He was baptized September 11, 1960 and had his First Communion in November 1967 at St Anthony's Church. He was educated in Baltimore City Schools and was a graduate of Dunbar Senior High School. He attended Morgan State University and majored in Psychology. At Morgan he was a member of Morgan's Magnificent Marching Band. In 1982 Paul met Dee and they were married on May 13, 1989. From this union two children were born, Paul the IV and Khayla Simone. Paul was a dedicated and committed employee of Villa Maria, a Catholic Charities Organization. Paul began working at Villa Maria Residential Treatment Center in 1982. In his 22 years of employment he won many accolades. One of his most memorable accolades was the Child Care Worker of the year award from the State of Maryland. He often volunteered for extra curricular activities that were associated with Villa Maria the football team, softball team, Villa fair, Villa talent show and camping trips. It was at Lombard Middle School where he began his love of music. He continued this love as he attended Dunbar and Morgan. In 1990 he began his own business forming The One D.J. Productions. He is well known as "The One DJ" as he was a member of Dan Sandy's Entertainment, Music Masters, Sounds Perfect and Encounters. He was a volunteer DJ for the Ed Block Courage awards for many years. He leaves behind a devoted wife, Deedri Rowlan-Carter; two children, Paul and Khayla; mother, Marie L Carter (nee Queen); father, Paul Frank Carter Jr.; a loving father and mother-in-law, Carl and Rosetta E

Rowlan; grandfathers, Milton Bing Sr., Husie Carl Rowlan Sr., three sisters, Joan Mears, Barbara Neal, Valerie Neilsen; one sister-in-law, Sharnet Chavis, four brothers-in-law, Corey Mears, Norman Neal Sr., Hans Neilsen and Jeffrey S.
