“ I'm reminded that I have known Paul since he was 7 or 8 years old. Even then he was smart, he was fun loving, he was ambitious -- he always wanted to be as big as his brother, as popular as his peers and, not rich, but successful. One thing he never gave himself enough credit for: he was good at almost anything he tried. He liked music so he taught himself some good guitar playing. He was good with his hands and so he did repairs and artistic paint designs for the walls of a house he was at. And over the last ten years, he wrote and recorded a lot of rap music that was sharp and tough and personal. He was good at all that.

More importantly, like all the Jackson/Love family, he had that one-of-a-kind winning personality -- even when he wasn't winning. I learned some of that strength from him and his brother. We can also learn from Paul's Bible namesake, the Apostle Paul, who wrote, "I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to come."

Our Paul was always restless but he's at rest now -- and it's up to us, friends and family, to carry on.
