Paul Andrew Williams, son of the “late” Milton E. Williams, Sr. and Magdalene Williams was born on March 3, 1958 in Baltimore, Maryland. He departed this life October 7, 2022 at Northwest Hospital.

Paul was raised in a devout Christian home. Early childhood, Paul attended Mt. Calvary Pentecostal Faith Church. Later, Faith Tabernacle Church under the “late” Reverend R.G. Hardy. And at times he visited New Life Evangelical Baptist Church under Reverend Milton E. Williams, Jr.

Paul graduated from Walbrook High School and later attended Coppin State University graduating in 2012 earning his bachelor’s degree in Applied Psychology. He was only a few credits away from receiving his master’s degree. He often spoke of the “late” Dr. Harold A. Carter, Senior Pastor of New Shiloh Baptist Church and the financial assistance he provided for college.

He met and married Robin Corrine Lee on July 30, 2010. Robin, a retired Coppin State University employee preceded him in death May 6, 2018.

Paul was employed with the Mayor & City Council of Baltimore.

(Department of Recreation & Parks). He was creative, taking risks, ignoring

doubt and facing fears. During his tenure with the local government, Paul met prominent politicians and attended a host of community events. Later retiring from the City of Baltimore.

He had a passion for the arts and specialized in carving African mask. Inspired by Tyler Perry, in 2019 he visited Atlanta to pursue his dream as a writer as he enjoyed creating poems and writing children's books.

Preceding him in death, siblings, Zelda B. Williams in 1980 and Linwood M. Chester, Jr. in 2015; stepfather, Linwood M. Chester, Sr. in 2016.

He is survived by his mother, Magdalene Chester; two sons, Samar Williams (Selina Battle) and Tavon Williams (Roxanne Walston; one daughter, Andrea Williams of Virginia (Carolyn Slowe); six grandchildren; one brother, Reverend Milton E. Williams Jr. (Myrtle); one sister, Tami Chester-Knox and step-sister, Cynthia Cleckley; nieces, nephews, cousins, uncles, aunts, a host friends, and a special friend his dog, Coley.
