In 1970, Peggy joined the workforce of the Social Security Administration, where she was the recipient of awards too numerous to mention, and in May 2000, after 30 years of employment, decided that it was time to retire. She enjoyed her retirement using her favorite pastimes of cooking and baking to their fullest. You could always get a plate of food, a slice of cake and more than often, an entire cake from her house.

Peggy became a member of The New Psalmist Baptist Church at it's then location on Cathedral and Franklin Streets. She proudly served on the Usher Board. An avid lover of hymns, it is belived that “Peace Be Still” and “O Holy Night” were her favorites.

In her later years, Peggy's health began to fail causing her to remain at home more and her children to now take care of her, which later led to her being placed at Future Care Nursing Home. A fighter to the very end, Peggy was called to her eternal home on Saturday, August 10, 2013
