



Percy Wilson Jr.

December 29, 1943 - September 9, 2023

Percy R. Wilson Jr. was born in Prince Edward County, Virginia, December 29, 1943, the eldest of five children (one girl and four boys to the late Percy R. Wilson, Sr. and Iva Pauline Wilson, His brothers Melvin Wilson and Franklin Wilson, Sr. preceded him in death.

Percy completed his high school education at Luther H. Foster High School in Crewe, Virginia. He served in the United States Army Reserves from July 1963 to November 1968

Percy was married to Joyce Taylor and later Wanda Watkins.

Percy was an entrepreneur who started a contract hauling business, P.R. Wilson Hauling. P.R. Wilson Hauling delivered cinder blocks and brick from the manufacturing plant yard to the various construction sites, throughout the eastern portion of Virginia. P.R. Wilson Hauling grew from a single flatbed truck, which required off-loading by hand to a small fleet of trucks with installed boom lifts.

In his leisure, Percy enjoyed playing baseball. He was instrumental in forming the Hanover Giants Baseball team where him and his friends would play other teams in the Central Virginia area. The Hanover Giants home was at Jack's Grill in Hanover County and they would play teams from Charles City, New

Kent, and Tappahannock.

He is survived by his devoted son, Percy R. Wilson III; loving sister, Margaret W. Cousin; warmhearted, brother Bennett C. Wilson Sr. (Anna); and a host of nieces, nephews, and caregivers.
