Philip "Justice" Forson died on February 28, 2009. He was born in Kumasi, Ghana to the late Georgina Gyamfi and Philip Forson on November 14, 1985. He attended primary school at Opoku Ware International School and completed his high school education at Opoku Ware Secondary School in Kumasi, Ghana. After completing high school Justice was called to minister and later received his Ministerial Ordination in Ghana. In 2003 he traveled to the United States to continue his education. He enrolled in Virginia Union University. He later relocated to Fort Meyers, Florida to attend Faith International Training School. He studied International Christian Studies and received his diploma in 2004. Justice believed he was here to serve the Lord and on December 3, 2007, he founded Glorious Family Ministeries for that purpose. He used his ministry as a vehicle to serve, worship and praise the Lord.
