Almighty God in His Infinite Wisdom carried PHILLIP PATTERSON GREEN on March 29, 2013 into an eternal rest in the House of the Kingdom of God. "Pops," as he was affectionately called, was born on June 22, 1927 to the late Arthur Lee Green and Mattie Sutherland in Baltimore, Maryland. Two sisters preceded him in death, Mary Dorantes and Shirley Yarbrough.

Phillip received his early education in the Baltimore City Public School System.

Phillip served in the United States Army during the Korean War and upon completion of his service was honorably discharged. He then went on to sail as a Merchant Seaman for two years. He was employed for fifty years as a Longshoreman at the Dundalk Marine Terminal, where he earned a certificate of completion in container repair for the International Longshoreman's Association from Dundalk Community College.

Phillip joined John Wesley United Methodist Church in June of 1996, where he accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior.

Phillip was an active and dedicated member of the Dorie Miller V.F.W. Post #5367 and the Walter Greene American Legion Post #14.

Pops was a kind, generous man who never complained. He was known as the "Whistler." His whistling in the morning was an alarm clock for many in the old neighborhood. He loved having "cookouts" and being surrounded by family and friends.
