Ms. Jones was born April 28, 1902 in Warren County, North Carolina and was the daughter of the late Sherman Williams and Eunice Spruill. Aunt Polly accepted Christ at an early age at the Coley Springs Baptist Church in Warren County, N.C. She completed her early education in Warren County. Following her move to Baltimore, Maryland in 1925, she furthered her education at Booker T. Washington School between 1933 and 1934. The Dandy family then employed her as a Domestic Engineer until her retirement. Aunt Polly was a member of several distinguished organizations that include The Past Grand Daughter Ruler's Council where she was a member since August 1975, and The Great Southern Temple #30 Elks of the World, where she was a member since January 1977. Ms. Jones was also bestowed a "Celebrating the Heritage and future of Christ Church " certificate during the 95th Anniversary of Trinity Baptist Church in Baltimore, Maryland. At the time of the award, Ms. Jones had been a member of the church for 50 years. Ms. Jones attended Trinity Baptist until her health no longer allowed her to do so. Even then, the devoted member that she was. Ms. Jones continued to pay her church dues whenever she was able.
