



Pondell Campbell

August 11, 1940 - November 19, 2023

Pondell Campbell age 83 peacefully passed away on Sunday November 19, 2023, after an 8-year battle with leukemia. Pondell was born on August 11, 1940, in Richmond, Virginia to Gertrude Martin Campbell and Samuel Campbell of Richmond, Virginia. Pondell was the oldest of 6 siblings 3 boys and 3 girls Katie, Rosalee and Julia. He was a graduate of Richmond Public School System and went on to serve 21 years in the Army. Pondell had an illustrious career receiving the bronze medal and 2 Purple Heart medals along with other medals and honors. After retiring from the Army, Pondell became a Deputy Sheriff for the Richmond Sheriff's Office for 23 1/2 years. During his time there, he met his wife, Patricia. After dating for 5 years, they married on February 14, 1995. He also worked for American Security Group for 10 years. Pondell enjoyed his retirement until his diagnosis of leukemia in December of 2015. He received treatment at McGuire Hunter Holmes Veterans Hospital. Pondell and Patricia leaned on their faith to bring them through this difficult time. Patricia took care of him for 8 years without complaining and truly exhibited patience and compassion for her husband's condition. Eventually his disease worsened and the VA stepped in. He was admitted to hospice care where he passed away. He leaves behind 3 children 2 daughters Felicia and Nina Campbell and Curtis Campbell all of Richmond, Virginia. One stepson David (Michelle) Smith and One stepdaughter Sheena Allen all of Richmond, Virginia. 4 grandchildren, 3 step grandchildren and a host of other family members.
