



## Prince Eugene Alston

December 31, 1935 - November 6, 2013

Prince Eugene Alston was born December 31, 1935, and departed this life on Wednesday, November 6, 2013 at 3:11 p.m. at St. Mary's Hospital, Henrico, Virginia. He was the son of Anthony and Kattie Williams Alston, both natives of Centerville, North Carolina. Both parents precede him in death. Prince had eight siblings: Matthew (wife-Linda), Charlie (wife-Maud), Stan (wife-Nettie), Ernest (wife-Yvonne), Mary (husband-Henry), and Cora (husband-John Henry), who all preceded him in death.
