



## Priscilla M. Kelly

February 26, 1922 - August 7, 2018

Priscilla Mary Kelly was born February 26, 1922. She is the child of the late Frank and Mariam Wallace.

Priscilla Mary Kelly was educated in both the parochial and public school systems – St. Peter Claver Elementary and Middle School and Douglass High School.

Priscilla Mary Kelly married Charles E. Blackwell, Sr. and from this union was born five boys: Charles, Robert (who preceded her in death) Leo, Wayland and Maurice Blackwell. She later married Harold B. Kelly.

Priscilla Mary Kelly accepted the Lord at an early age, having received her sacraments at St. Peter Claver Catholic Church. After leaving St. Bernadine's Catholic Church she joined and became very active at St. Edward's Catholic Church. At St. Edward's she was a member of the Blessed Mother Sodality, the 260 Club, the Pastor's Circle and the Servants of the Crucified Savior. She was also active in Lost & Found Ministries. She served as the President of the Robert Jerome Blackwell Foundation.

Priscilla Mary Kelly prayed the rosary daily and concluded with the prayer of St. Anthony. When able, she would then call all her children and sisters and pray:

“May the Lord watch between me and thee as we are absent one from another”

She would not be satisfied until we shouted back: AMEN.

Priscilla Mary Kelly was known for her patience, hospitality, generosity, kindness, and smile. Whenever she stepped out she made a fashion statement, especially with her styles and creative hats. She would always remind people of two things: (1) don't ever mess with my boys; (2) please wash your hands.

Priscilla Mary Kelly was a worker. She worked at JJ-Brills, and Tommy Tucker. She for many years was a domestic engineer. After more than thirty years she retired from Hochschild Kohn Department Store.

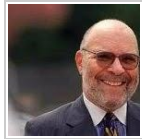
