QUANDA LOVERE COATES (lovingly known as Sissie) was born to the late James Otis Bryant Sr. and Thelma Lee Bryant on January 16, 1947 in Nash County, NC. Sissie was one of the 1st black females admitted to the nursing program and later graduated from Mergenthaler Vocational Technical High School. Sissie departed this life to go on to glory and rest with the Lord on Thursday, August 31, 2017 at 12:45 p.m.

At a young age, Sissie was baptized at First Mount Calvary Baptist Church of Baltimore, Maryland. Her first job was at Reeds Pharmacy. She later worked at Montgomery Wards and as a substitute teacher in the Baltimore Public Schools. There are many things she is known for, but these are just a few: Sissie was a very intelligent, trustworthy and nice woman; an avid reader; and a second mother to her siblings. She protected them, stood by their side and loved them like her own.
